## HPC Roadshow 2013

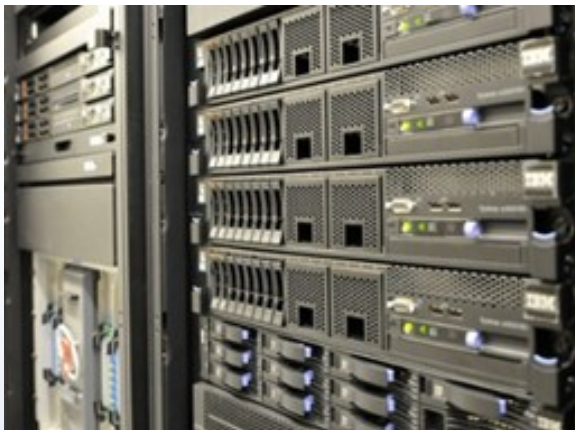
